New Business

Treasurer's report: \$2634.53 The field rent has been paid (\$950) and the insurance for the field (\$325) has been paid.

The topic of a mall show was brought up. However, since Bob Addison, who said he was going to contact both malls about scheduling a show, wasn't at the meeting it was assumed that there would be no mall show this year. At least a month lead time is required to obtain the insurance from the AMA and the show is normally held around the 1st of April so next meeting is too late to get the paperwork going.

It was mentioned that our club president, Steve Elkins would be undergoing back surgery in the next couple of weeks. The club members wish you the best Steve.

Vice-president Kitts reported that a damage assessment party (i.e. 2 club members) had gone out to the field to assess the damage caused when the wind blew the pavilion into the storage building. According to the assessment party the pavilion is a tangled mess and will need to be cut up and scrapped. How and when this will be done and what to do about replacing the pavilion will be discussed at future meetings.

A lengthy discussion ensued about the care, feeding, and cycling of the batteries in your radios and your airplanes during this off season and in preparation for the upcoming flying season.
